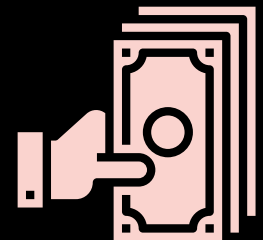
INDUSTRY

WHY STUDY CERTIFICATE COURSE IN PROJECT MANAGEMENT?



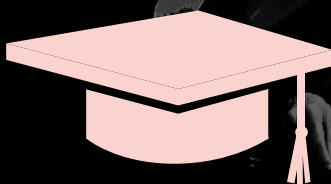
